## Requirements

- Applicant must attend the 2017 Family Reunion and have a minimum GPA of a 2.8 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicant must be a high school senior who has been accepted to a college, university, or vocational school or a college student that's in good academic standing. Transcripts are required to prove your academic record. Proof of registration for courses for the upcoming academic year must be provided.
- Applicant is required to write an essay on one of the following topics:
  - *“Parents, Family, and Community: The importance of their involvement in my education and success”*
  - *"Describe an experience that had a significant impact on you and how it contributed to you choosing to focus on your specific educational or career objectives."*

Essay should include the details of your family lineage (i.e., Nichole Hill, Daughter of Cordelia Hill, Grand-Daughter of Clydia Curtis (Barefield), and Great-Grand-Daughter of Arlene Barefield). The essay should be typed, doubled-spaced, and limited to two pages.

**Awards:** The value of the scholarships awarded is based on the funds available and the number of awardees.
